

## **SAFETY OFFICER (1)**

The Safety Officer must be an accredited safety practitioner by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) and must have undergone the prescribed forty (40) hour Construction Safety and Health Training (COSH). The above key personnel listed are required. The Builder Contractor (BC) may, as needed and at its own expense, supply additional professionals and/or support personnel for the optimal performance of all Construction Services, as stipulated in these Terms of Reference, for the Project. Prospective bidders shall attach each individual's resume, PRC license of the professional staff, certificates of training and all other pertinent documents proving the said professional's expertise.

### **Project Requirements:**


The Contractor shall comply:

- a. Time Schedule: One (1) Month
- b. Schedule of Work shall conform to meet the given Time Schedule.
- c. Equipment: at least 3-man-lift truck with driver/operator, 1- boom truck with driver/operator and 2-service trucks/vehicles with driver
- d. Tools: at least 5 line-man tools, high voltage set of gloves, PPE's
- e. Competent workers: provide at least 5 first class lineman, 1 authorized foreman

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
