However, we wish to remind your team that the satisfactory implementation of these planned actions will be verified at the next audit.

Please note the opportunities for improvement cited too in the audit report.

We also wish to bring to your attention our concern that, in addition to the above-cited non-conformity report, four non-conformity reports from Stage 2 in September 2019 remain open. The audit in December 2020 found insufficient or no evidences of implementation of corrections and corrective actions committed to be done on non-conformity reports AGB-01-ST2, LGR-01-ST2, Team-01-ST2, and Team-02-ST2. The status of these actions will again be verified at the next audit. To ensure maintenance of certification, it is imperative under ISO rules that these continual improvement actions are effectively implemented in a timely manner.
